Scrapbook Regulations:

- 1)** Each school may enter only one scrapbook
- 2)** Maximum size is 14" x 14"
- 3)** Scrapbook reflects student council projects and events only
- 4)** The number of camera photographs is limited to 100, excluding newspaper photos with captions, A "picture" of several pictures (collage) shall be counted as the higher number.
- 5)** Do not include 3-dimensional objects.
- 6)** Each scrapbook will be judged on the criteria listed, originality, neatness and activities represented.
- 7)** Must be put together in this order:
 - a) Title Page
 - I)** Name of council (i.e.: Mishicot Student Council)
 - II)** Name of school (i.e.: Mishicot Middle School School)
 - III)** Name of community (i.e.: Mishicot)
 - b) Council Page divider
 - I)** Photo of council officers with names and offices held
 - II)** Photo of advisors with names
 - III)** Photo of whole council with names
 - c) Leadership Activities divider
 - I)** Definition of leadership activities: Activities that teach, promote, or develop Leadership skills (i.e. student council retreat)
 - II)** Pages depicting leadership activities, as many as you choose to include
 - d) Local Activities/Community Projects divider
 - I)** Definition of local activities/community projects: Activities/projects that serve the local community (i.e. fundraising for a local charity, volunteering at senior center). e) Fundraising Projects divider
 - I)** Definition of fundraising projects: Activities/events that serve to raise money for the student council
 - II)** Pages depicting fundraising projects, as many as you choose to include
 - f) Recreational/Social Activities divider
 - I)** Definition of Recreational/Social Activities: Activities that involved building the camaraderie and/or teamwork of the student council as a whole (i.e. council Christmas party)
 - II)** Pages depicting recreational/social activities, as many as you choose to include
 - g) Regional Activities divider
 - I)** Definition of regional activities: Activities/events that are hosted by one of the WASC Regions (i.e. Fall Summit)
 - II)** Pages depicting regional activities, as many as you choose to include

h) State/National divider (if applicable)

I) Definition of state/national activities: Activities/events that are hosted by the WASC/NASC (i.e. state conference, leadership institute)
